**Terms of Payment:**

Due Date for tax payment is as noted on first page. Post-dated cheques no later than the due date will be accepted. If mailed, the envelope must bear a postmark no later than the due date noted on first page.

**Penalties:** As shown on the first page.

**Note:**

Any payment for property tax forwarded by mail shall be deemed to have been received on the same date as the postmark stamped on the envelope. Cancelled cheque(s) will act as receipt. Customer Receipt: if you require a receipt of payment, please contact the Village office by email to request a written receipt of payment

Any property with respect to which the taxes are in arrears is liable to proceedings under the Municipal Government Act. Where taxes are paid by a mortgage company, the owner is responsible for ensuring taxes are paid on time. An appeal against your assessed property value does not exempt you from paying on time or from late payment penalties. If an appeal is successful, the adjustment will be applied to next year's tax roll.

**Education Taxes:**

Inquiries pertaining to education taxes should be directed to your school board or Alberta Education Property Taxes.

**Assessment Complaints:**

If you believe your own or any other assessment is unfair, you may file a written complaint to the Assessment Review Board. The Assessment Review Board has the Authority to review your assessment and direct the assessor to make amendments. Its function is to hear evidence as to whether your property is assessed on an equitable basis to similar properties.

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act.

A complaint must be in writing.

A complaint must explain why the complainant thinks that information shown on an assessment or tax notice is incorrect.

**Note:**

Your complaint must be received by July 29, 2026. Copies of the complaint form and the assessment complaints agent authorization forms are available by contacting the Village office or on the municipal website. You are entitled to see or receive sufficient information about your property in accordance with Section 299 of the Act or a summary of an assessment may be obtained from the Village office upon your request or your representative providing proof of agency or representation. A \$150.00 fee must accompany the complaint.


