Summer Village of Bonnyville Beach Council Meeting by email to consider a motion that the Summer Village of Bonnyville Beach continue to participate in two restructured intermunicipal boards: Joint Assessment Review Board & Intermunicipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Boards.

### **Motion received by email on March 24, 2026**

**Motion 2026-127** - That the Summer Village of Bonnyville Beach participate in the Joint Assessment Review Board and the Intermunicipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board, entering into agreement with the Town of Bonnyville and other partner municipalities for Joint Assessment Review Board Services and for Intermunicipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Services.

### **Background Information:**

**ACTION REQUIRED** - At March 18, 2026 SVBB Council meeting we discussed SVBB representation on two intermunicipal boards: Joint Assessment Review Board & Intermunicipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board.

The Village sent the name and contact information for Deputy Mayor Laurie Gardner to be a representative on the boards (Feb 25, 2026).

We received two letters from the MD CAO on March 13, 2026. The MD letters were also sent by registered mail, received on March 20, 2026.

On March 19, the Village spoke Stephanie Severin, Director, Legislative & Information Services at the MD about the letters and to find out what happened? We were informed that the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 is giving notice to withdraw from participation in both these boards.

With the withdrawal of the MD from the two boards, the boards will be restructured and the Town of Bonnyville, as the largest participating municipality, will assume the role of coordinator.

Special Meeting by Email of the Summer Village of Bonnyville Beach Council – March 24, 2026

On March 20, 2026, the Village was contacted by, Dan Heney, Director of Emergency Management and General Manager of Planning and Community Service at the Town of Bonnyville. He will require official notice from the Summer Village indicating that the SVBB will continue to be a participation municipality, like Glendon and Pelican Narrows, on the two boards: Joint Assessment Review Board & Intermunicipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board.

After we agree to participate, an agreement will be signed. The current signed agreement will not be effective after the dates for the formal withdrawal of the MD of Bonnyville have passed.

The SVBB requires that this be approved by motion. After the SVBB Council has approved participation in the boards, this information will be sent to Dan Heney, at the Town of Bonnyville. He will send the required agreements for signing later.
